## 8 STEAM PLAYERS SELECTED AS GREAT LAKES ALL-STARS

Eight Steam players were selected to participate in the Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League All-Star game. First basemen Drew Roberts (Jr. / Xavier University/ Sycamore) was selected after hitting .254 with one home run and 11 RBI. Former Oak Hills graduate Brandon Besl was selected after hitting .284 with one homerun and seven RBI. Also making the all-star game is the Steam's leading hitter Josh Harrison (Fr.

Cincinnati/Princeton) posting a .315 average with a .416 on base percentage. Former LaSalle pitcher and now a Northern Kentucky University sophomore, Matt Winterhalter was selected to the team after posting a 1-1 record with five saves. Also reining from NKU and a graduate of Dixie Heights, Kory Lonergan made the team as he posts a .258 batting average with twelve RBI. Another local pitcher Matt Marksburry, a graduate from Norwood and also currently plays at NKU



was selected after putting up a team best 3-2 record with a 2.01 ERA. The Steam's centerfielder Adam Pasano (Xavier University) was also selected to the all-star team with a .260 batting average and eight RBI. Tony Kennedy (Ohio State) rounds up the local all-stars batting .280 and leads the Steam with 13 RBI. The game was scheduled to be played at Bob Wren Stadium on the Ohio University campus.

### SPOTLIGHT ON MATT MARKSBURRY

Although the Steam has struggled with the bats lately their starting pitching has been dominant. As of late, the Steam has placed a much more needed emphasis on pitching rather than hitting to win games. Leading the way is junior pitcher Matt Marksburry a Norwood High School graduate. Matt has played a key role in the Steam's starting rotation. He leads the team with three wins and a 2.01 ERA.

Matt currently attends Northern Kentucky University where he is the Norse's number one starter. He posted a 6-5 record last season



with a 4.06 earned run average, he walked just ten batters in 64 1/3 innings pitched and struck out 32.
